RULES FOR STORAGE AND COLLECTION

BULK WASTE COLLECTION IS EVERY WEEK ON SECOND COLLECTION DAY OF THE WEEK - LIMITED TO THREE (3) ITEMS PER COLLECTION, PER HOUSEHOLD

The collection of bulk waste from residential curbside consists of, but is not limited to: major household appliances, fixtures, ovens, refrigerators, washing machines, dryers, storm windows, windows screens and hardcover books. Latex paint, if solidified in opened cans, will be collected.

No construction materials accepted. Failure to comply with these simple rules and regulations will result in a summons issued to you.

No automotive parts (tires).

RECLYCLING (ENTIRE TOWNSHIP) EVERY WEDNESDAY ALTERNATING COMINGLED AND NEWSPAPER/CARDBOARD, EVERY OTHER WEEK (REFER TO SCHEDULE)

Place aluminum cans, steel cans, unbroken glass and plastic bottles (milk, soda, bleach, and detergent bottles) rinsed out in one reusable container with recycling sticker on front.

Newspapers, magazines, telephone and paperback books should be tied or bundles.

Only motor oil will be accepted at the Public Works Yard in its proper receptacle.
