# HILLSIDE RECYCLES

**NOTICE TO ALL TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE RESIDENTS AND  
BUSINESSES**

**JUST A REMINDER:  
RECYCLING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE  
IS MANDATORY**

All residents and businesses alike are required to recycle newspaper, cardboard and comingled items (glass, aluminum cans, steel containers and certain plastic containers such as polyethylene terephthalate (PETE#1) soda bottles, high density poly ethylene (HDPE#2) milk, water and detergent bottles.

**Effective immediately, Code Enforcement Personnel from the Township's Department of Public Works will be checking for compliance throughout the Township. Failure to recycle will cause the solid waste not to be collected until all items are properly separated.**

Additionally, in accordance with Township Ordinance 261-38 (Solid waste), any individual or corporation found guilty, could face fines up to \$2000.00. The Department of Public Works thanks the individuals in the Township of Hillside who continue to recycle.
