



LEAF SEASON

The 2023 leaf collection from the roadway gutter area will commence on October 30th, 2023 and continue through December 15th, 2023. Residents are asked at that time to rake leaves into the street 4"-6" from the curb to allow for drainage. Crews will pick up the leaves on scheduled street cleaning days <u>depending on weather conditions</u>. Piles of leaves will **not** be picked up if they contain branches, grass, brush, stones, or garbage.

IF YOU HAVE ANY ADDITIONAL LEAVES, BAG THEM FOR DISPOSAL ON YOUR SECOND GARBAGE DAY (COLLECTION DAY ONLY) AS ONE OF YOUR THREE (3) PIECES OF BULK.

VEGETATIVE WASTE

ORDINANCE 261-6 & 261-16

Vegetative waste includes grass, branches, and leaves.

Tree branch bundles should meet the following criteria to be placed at the curb for bulk pick up:

- Weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds.
- Maximum four (4) feet in length.
- Each branch should be ten (10) inches or less in diameter (includes trucks and stumps)
- Should be tied and bundled.

All other vegetative waste must be placed in biodegradable paper bags when placed at the curb for bulk pick up. Free leaf bags provided by Department of Public Works.

Additional Services

- Bulk Items: The collection of bulk waste from residential curbside consists of major household appliances, refrigerators (doors removed), washer, dryer and latex paint if solidified in an opened can.
- Mattresses/ Box springs:

All mattresses and box springs must be cover completely in plastic and discarded for bulk day pick up. Please notify DPW before placing mattresses curbside, (973) 926-1110.

• Snow Removal:

During snow days please do not shovel snow into the street. No parking on snow routes during snowfall. Please try and park in driveway when possible. Residential sidewalks must be cleared of snow within 12 hours of finished snowfall. It is against the law to use any object to hold a parking spot on a public street. Make sure when you clean off your vehicle, you clean the snow towards the curb line.
